Students Help Take A Bite Out Of School Funding Cutbacks By ... Eating

Participating in the National School Breakfast and Lunch programs can turn food service departments into self-funded profit centers for School Districts.

Jacksonville, FL – March 9, 2010 - Throughout the country protesting students carry signs for academic programs that are being eliminated due to budget shortfalls. Federal and State budgets have been reduced causing School Districts to cut programs to stay afloat.

Many School Districts fund food service programs with money that could go toward academic programs.

Three main reasons for students not eating in school are “Cafeteria looks unappealing”, “Perception that school food is unappetizing”, and “Stigma of eating in cafeteria” says Schuster.
